Funds or property remaining in the holdings of this corporation upon its dissolution shall become the property of the Friends of the Middleboro Public Library Trust which will be established upon the dissolution of the corporation pursuant to the trust agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein with the trustees of the Middleboro Public Library appointed as trustees. The Board of Directors is empowered to execute a Trust agreement not inconsistent with these By-Laws and the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
